

Proposal for Non-Teaching Faculty Chaperone on a Global Experience or Maymester Study Abroad Program

High Point University requires two university faculty to accompany each Global Experience or Maymester study abroad program. Permission for a single faculty leader can be requested by the individual teaching faculty and the Office of Global Education in special circumstances only.

All non-teaching faculty chaperones must be approved by October 1.

Personal qualifications (professionalism; complementary skills to the teaching faculty) and professional qualifications (previous experience in host country; previous experience leading study abroad; future interest in developing and leading a Global Experience program) should be considered when proposing a non-teaching faculty chaperone.
